Today **I wish I was a songwriter**....because I would totally write a song that sings the praises of **this wonder cure** I have been using lately.

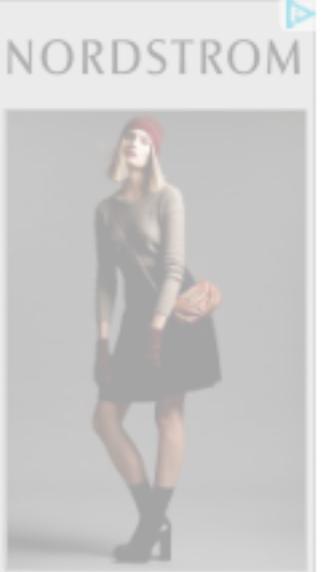
Just a little background before I start my serenade. :-)

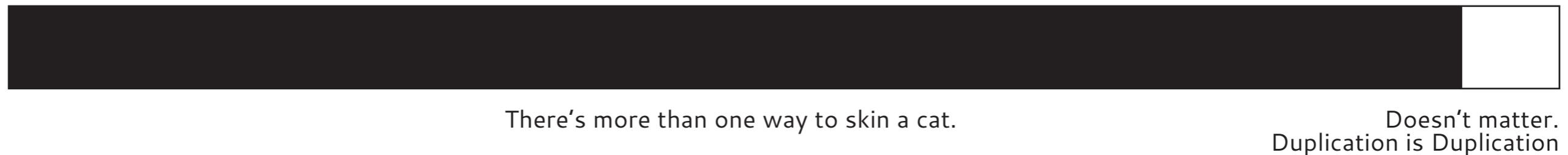
DO YOU FIND A LOT OF BLOGS REPEAT THE SAME TUTORIAL OR RIFFS ON THE SAME IDEA?

WHAT IF THAT BLOGGER SHARED ANOTHER WAY TO DO THE PROJECT?



NOTHING IS ORIGINAL. PERIOD.

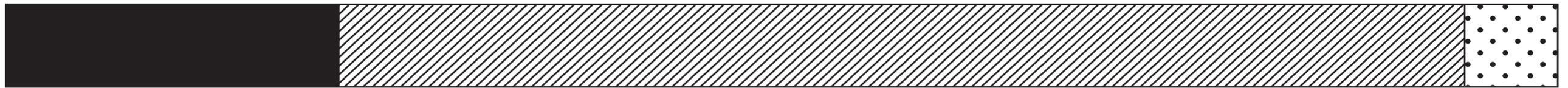
- It's *not* creating another skinny jean tutorial
- It's *not* doing regurgated round-up

WHAT IS ORIGINAL CONTENT?

- It's solving unique problems
- It's using unique materials
- It's *making* and featuring other tutorial(s)
- It's doing something for *you*

TOUGH QUESTIONS: *do you copy retail?*

IS IT OKAY FOR BLOGGERS TO SHARE DIYs ON RETAIL PRODUCTS?



It's only okay if that item is way out of a normal price range or sold by a large company.

It wouldn't take away from business. DIYers are never going to purchase it anyway.

Absolutely not!! You're taking business away!

- Find a way to support business both large and small
- We are creatives, we can think outside the box

TOUGH QUESTIONS: *do you self-promote?*

IS IT OKAY FOR BLOGGERS TO PIN THEIR OWN POSTS?



Yes! Categorize it in a board clearly marked for self-promotion

Yes! Categorize it in the boards you would normally pin it to.

NO!

Listen to your gut and think about
what works best for you

TOUGH QUESTIONS: *do you research?*

- If you find a tutorial that's identical to what you had originally planned – do you still do it?
- Do you create or do you try to become an expert in that particular DIY or technique prior to creating?
- Do you search before you post? Do you link to similar items?
